Young farmer Johanna Strasser from Absam shows us how bread was baked centuries ago: Freshly ground grain is mixed with natural yeast and rich spices to make fragrant farmhouse bread. The still warm farmhouse bread tastes fantastic with real butter and a refreshment to go with it. Fantastic!

4 PM OF WILD HEADS, FROGS AND A QUEEN

Themed tour Hall

Hall was the first town in Tyrol to have a water pipe from the Halltal valley in 1411, which fed the public fountains and supplied the town and its inhabitants with precious drinking water. Over the centuries, numerous fountains in the public space have been created by artists. We still encounter them in the cityscape today. Also the general history of Hall will not be neglected either with this tour. A journey of discovery of a different kind!

10 AM MONEY RULES THE WORLD

Mint Museum Hall

Up to the Mint Tower, Hall's landmark, and the permanent exhibition of the museum in Hasegg Castle this varied tour, which covers the history of Hall as a prin-

cely minting centre and birthplace of the First Thaler of the World. An unforgettable view of the Karwendel and Tyrol's largest old town round off this themed tour.

4 PM THE INN AND SHIPPING

Themed tour Hall

Salt, silver and shipping were once the three pillars of the up-and-coming medieval town of Hall. An extensive walk leads from the former salt works district to the Untere Lend, the main harbour for Tyrolean fluvial transport, where for centuries barges and flat boats moored to bring important goods to the city.

FRIDAYS

9 AM ON THE TRACKS OF THE GLUNGEZER GIANT

Guided hike Tulfes

From the Tulfes mountain station, this hike through old Swiss stone pine leads to the Zirbensee lake and on to an altitude of 2,677 metres. The „White Mountain“ is shrouded in many stories and anecdotes that make the way up to the summit cross entertaining and exciting. Yippie!

2 PM LAMATREKKING

Guided hike Wattenberg

A shuttle service (see below) will take you from the Halltal valley entrance to St Magdalena inn on a wild and romantic path along the Halltalbach stream to the Issboden, known for its diversity of plants. Equipped with Swarovski binoculars and a bit of luck you can spot chamois, ibexes and golden eagles!
